












One Size does NOT fit all




TODs vs. ITE standards:

- 44% fewer trips
- 48-49% fewer peak-hour trips


Benefits of Right-size Parking Requirements



On a typical 8-acre TOD...

- 225 more homes
- \$5.3 million cost savings
- 82,875 more transit trips/yr

Travel Patterns of Bay Area Households Living in Transit Neighborhoods


- 30% Car-Free
- Drive 50% less
- 4 times more likely to walk
- 10 times more likely to use transit


