






LEED civic bldg	Fire station	43 tons
Food Waste	1 ton	1 ton
Business Recycling (paper, cardboard)	1 ton	4 tons



### **And Purchasing Matters**

- No Green Jobs Without Demand for Green Products
- State & Local Government Spending = \$400 Billion / Yr
- Large Corporate Supply Chains Have Similar Leverage

Purchasing Practice	Metric	CO2 Reduction
30% Post-Consumer Paper	20 Cases	1 Ton
98% Post-Consumer Plastic	15 Plastic Park Benches	1 Ton
25% Post-Consumer Plastic	100 96-Gallon Carts	1 Ton
100% Post-Consumer Recycled Rubber	900 Pounds	1 Ton



#### How Can You Increase Demand for Green Jobs?

- Increase Diversion Far Beyond 50%. Use Landfill Bans or Mandatory Recycling, If Necessary
- Require Green Point Rated Homes or LEED Certification for Civic and Private Buildings
- Require Bay-Friendly Civic and Private Landscapes
- Join the Bay-Friendly Regional Coalition
- Buy Recycled Content Products and Join Our Packaging Reduction and Pooled Purchasing Efforts
- Raise Rates When Necessary, or When Revenue Can Be Used to Reduce Other Municipal Fees or Taxes (Remember, Diversion is a Low-Cost Climate Action)
